

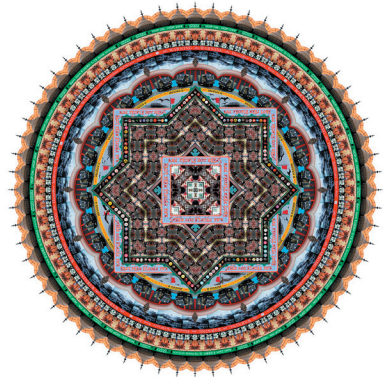
Home is Where the Art Is
